RESOLUTION NO. 2017-008

APPROVAL TO ADOPT THE PUEBLO OF ACOMA 2017-2018 TROPHY HUNT PROCLAMATION

At a duly called meeting of the Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council, held on this **24th day of March, 2017** the following resolution was adopted:


WHEREAS:


- Section No. 1 The Pueblo of Acoma is a sovereign Indian Nation, recognized as such by the federal government of the United States of America, and in the exercise of its tribal sovereignty remains organized in accordance with Pueblo tradition; and
- Section No. 2 The Pueblo of Acoma accepted the terms of the Indian Reorganization Act (Congressional Act of June 18, 1934, Chapter 576, Codified at 25 United States Code § 461-479 ("IRA")). However, the Pueblo is not organized under the IRA and has no written Constitution; and
- Section No. 3 The Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council is the legislative authority for the Pueblo of Acoma and has the responsibility to adopt laws applicable on the lands of the Pueblo. This resolution is passed in exercising the responsibilities and authorities of the Tribal Council for and in the best interest of the Pueblo of Acoma; and
- Section No. 4 The Pueblo of Acoma has jurisdiction over fishing, hunting, and trapping activities within the Pueblo of Acoma lands in accordance with Pueblo of Acoma Laws-Title 7 Game and Wildlife Code; and
- Section No. 5 The authority for licensing such activities resides exclusively in the Pueblo of Acoma through:
- a) Pueblo of Acoma Laws-Title 7 Game and Wildlife Code; and
 - b) Pueblo of Acoma Trophy Hunt Proclamation; and
- Section No. 6 A proposed Pueblo of Acoma Trophy Hunt Proclamation must be reviewed and approved by the Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council in consideration of game and wildlife data analysis such as population counts, health reports, and past successful hunt counts, etc.


RESOLUTION NO. 2017-008

NOW THEREFORE BE IS RESOLVED THAT:

- Section No. 1 The Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council approves the Pueblo of Acoma 2017-2018 Trophy Hunt Proclamation which will begin **May 1, 2017** and end **April 30, 2018**, **attached to this resolution**; and
- Section No. 2 The Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council directs the Acoma Game and Fish Enterprise to conduct the Pueblo of Acoma 2017-2018 Trophy Hunt Proclamation; and
- Section No. 3 The Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council also directs the Acoma Law Enforcement Department to provide enforcement of all pertinent regulations contained within, but not limited to:
- a) The Pueblo of Acoma 2017-2018 Trophy Hunt Proclamation; and
- b) The Pueblo of Acoma Laws-Title 7 Game and Wildlife Code, Title 9 Livestock and Grazing Code, Title 10 Traffic Code; and
- Section No. 4 The Pueblo of Acoma Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Governor, and his designee(s), to execute all actions and documents necessary to initiate the intent of this resolution.


